VACANCY FOR A PARISH COUNCILLOR

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 (SECTION 87(2)) THE LOCAL ELECTIONS (PARISHES AND COMMUNITIES) (ENGLAND AND WALES) RULES 2006 (RULE 5)

- (1) There are two vacancies on the above-mentioned Council caused by the resignation of Councillor Ken Batty and Councillor Jeff Carroll.
- (2) By-elections to fill the vacancies must be held if, within 14 days from the date of the publishing of this Notice, ten electors for the Parish give notice, in writing, to the Returning Officer of their request for an election.
- (3) If a by-election is called it will not be held until 6 May 2021 in line with the Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020.
- (3) The Returning Officer for Parish Elections is Simon McVey, South Lakeland District Council, South Lakeland House, Lowther Street, Kendal.
- (4) If no such notice is given, the Parish/Town Council must fill the vacancies by co-option as soon as practicable after the expiry of the period of 14 days referred to at Paragraph (2) above.
